## The removal of names from the National List in accordance with Resolution 1373 adopted by the UN Security Council

- The Committee receives a request to remove the name of individual(s) or entities from Members of the Committee, Local Authorities, or the individual(s) or entities listed in the National List.
- The Committee shall send the request to the relevant Law Enforcement Agencies to provide all the data and information available at their esteemed disposal.
- If the Committee finds that the information provided by the relevant Law Enforcement Agencies is no longer sufficient to keep the name of individual(s) or entities in the National List, the Committee shall then lift the listed from the list as per the regulations Ministerial Resolution 141/2023.
- The Committee for the Implementation of Security Council Resolutions under Chapter VII of the United Nations Charter shall hold a meeting to formally ratify their decision to remove the names of the individual(s) or entities in question. The ratification shall be mentioned in the minutes of the meeting.
- The relevant authorities shall take all the needed measures to enforce the decision of the Committee without delays as per their professional scope.
- The Committee shall send a handwritten letter to the individual(s) or entities listed or removed from the List. The relevant authority shall make sure, though a member of the Committee, that the decision is circulated and implemented.
